

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES: The regatta shall be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2005-2008, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the rules of the Club 420 class, and this Notice of Race (except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions), and by the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

2.1 This regatta is open to all high school teams. All competitors must be full time students, in the 9th grade or higher, of the school they represent, and subject to the academic and disciplinary requirements of that school.

2.2 For a school to be eligible to compete, an adult who is responsible for the school's team must accompany the team to the regatta.

2.3 Schools may enter as many teams as they choose, subject to Section 4.1 (below). If your school has more than one team, please enter as team 1, 2, 3, etc.

2.4 If a school lacks sufficient sailors to form a complete team, teams may be formed by "mixing and matching" sailors from different schools.

3. REGISTRATION & ENTRY FEE

3.1 Teams may register by completing the accompanying entry and waiver forms and sending to George Yioulos at West Coast Sailing (FAX: 503-467-4564; email: george@westcoastsailing.net).

3.2 Entry fee is \$10 per sailor (includes lunch and prizes). Payment may be made at registration.

4. BOATS:

4.1 Willamette Sailing Club will provide 8 Club 420s. Entries shall be limited to this number of teams, on a first come, first served basis, unless other participants can bring more boats (please notify George Yioulos at george@westcoastsailing.net if you are able to bring boats).

4.2 Boats shall be rotated among the competing teams in round robin format. Sequence and frequency of boat exchanges shall be at the discretion of the Race Committee.

4.3 If a round robin is not completed, the regatta shall consist of the number of races sailed up until the conclusion of racing.

5.3 First Warning: 1100

5.5 No Races after 1530

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Will be available at the competitors meeting.

7. SAILING AREA: Races will be held on the Willamette River between the Sellwood Bridge and the Ross Island Bridge.

8. SCORING: The low point scoring system, rule A2, will apply. Each team's score will be the sum of its A & B division scores in all races (no throwouts).

9. TROPHIES: Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishing teams.
