NOTICE OF RACE

Willamette Sailing Club, July 25th, 2009

Holley Cup is organized by the Willamette Sailing Club and is open to boats meeting the requirements listed below.

Rules: The Regatta will be governed by the current *Racing Rules of Sailing* and the *US Sailing Prescriptions*, except as any of these may be altered by the Sailing Instructions or by class rules that do not conflict with the Rules, Prescriptions or Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility: Competitors must be female. There are no age restrictions for entrants. The purpose of this race is to get more woman sailors out on the water. For this reason, there are no further eligibility requirements.

Safety: Race safety rules will follow those as outlined by the Willamette Sailing Club.

- All competitors shall wear a US Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Device (PFD) while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing.
- All boats shall carry the following safety equipment:
 1. One bailing device (portable or through-hull)
 2. One horn or whistle audible for at least ½ mile
 3. Bowline at least equal to the length of the boat
 4. Any other safety equipment required by state or federal law
- Further rules will be outlined within the sailing instructions passed out on the day of the race.

Classes: This year's participants may compete in either the Laser class or in the International 420. Charters will be made available for those needing access to a laser. The Willamette Sailing Club is generously allowing the use of their 420's to all interested parties.

Schedule: Three completed races will constitute a series. Skippers' meeting will be held at the WSC clubhouse at 1300 hours on Saturday, July 25th. Warning for the first race Saturday is scheduled for 1330 hours. Dinner will be served after racing with presentation of awards.

Course/Race Instructions: Will be given on the day of the race.

Fees: \$20 per race entry. Fee includes dinner for participants Saturday evening.

From I5 South

Take exit 299A (Lake Oswego/Macadam Ave.). Once on the off ramp, merge to one of the right 2 lanes (otherwise you will end up back on I5 South). This will dump you down onto Macadam Ave. Continue South until you see the Pacific Pride gas station on your left. Get in the left hand turn lane at the Pacific Pride gas station. It may not look like a road, but when you turn you'll see the masts ahead (this is actually SW Carolina Street).

From I5 North

Take exit 298 (Corbett) and turn right at the stop sign onto Corbett. Follow Corbett down to the bottom of the hill where you will run into a four-way stop at the intersection of Corbett and Boundary. Take a left onto Boundary. GO to the stoplight and turn right onto Macadam Ave. Go until you see the Pacific Pride gas station on the left. Get in the left hand turn lane at the Pacific Pride gas station. It may not look like a road, but when you turn you'll see the masts ahead (this is actually SW Carolina Street).
