2009 WSC Vancouver Lake Youth Regatta

Area L Eliminations - 2009 Chubb US Sailing Junior Champs for the Sears, Bemis, & Smythe Trophies

Vancouver Lake, WA, June 20-21, 2009

You are invited to compete in the 2009 Vancouver Lake Youth Regatta, sponsored by Willamette Sailing Club and hosted by the Vancouver Lake Sailing Club. The Regatta will be governed by the current *Racing Rules of Sailing* and the *US Sailing Prescriptions*, except as any of these may be altered by the Sailing Instructions or by class rules that do not conflict with the Rules, Prescriptions or Sailing Instructions.

This Regatta is the third event of the 2009 NW Youth Racing Circuit and will serve as Area L Eliminations for the 2009 Chubb US Sailing Junior Championships for the Sears (triple-handed), Bemis (double-handed) and Smythe (single-handed) Trophies.

Eligibility: Competitors must be 18 years of age and under except that Optimist competitors shall be no older than 15 years of age during the 2009 calendar year. Older entrants may compete but will not be eligible for prizes. Optimist Fleet awards: Red (born in 1996 or earlier), Blue (born 1997-1998), and White (born 1999 or later). Optimist Green Fleet (Novice) competitors will receive participant medals.

Sears, Bemis & Smythe Eligibility: Skippers and crews must have reached their 13th birthday but not their 19th birthday during the 2009 year, must be members of US Sailing, and must be members of the same sailing club. Classes: Opti (Red, Blue, White, Green), Laser Full Rig (Smythe), Laser Radial, International 420 (Bemis), Lightning (Sears), Vanguard 15 and O'pen Bic dinghy. The International 420 class will sail with trapeze and spinnaker. The Lightning class will sail with spinnakers. *Lightnings are available for charter for crews competing in the Sears eliminations. A \$500 refundable damage deposit is required for charter, and arrangements must be made with the Regatta Chairman by June 15.*

Schedule: Up to six races per day are scheduled, but three completed races will constitute a series. Skippers' meeting will be held at the VLSC clubhouse at 1100 hours on Saturday, June 20. Warning for the first race Saturday is scheduled for 1230 hours. Warning for the first race Sunday is scheduled for 1000 hours. No races will be started after 1430 hours on Sunday.

Registration: You can register online at www.willamettesailingclub.com or complete the registration form below and mail it with a check for all fees to WSC. Registrations received by June 15 receive a \$10 discount. All participants and their parents must sign the WSC Consent & Waiver of Liability Agreement. On-site registration will take place at VLSC from 0900-1100 hours on Saturday, June 20.

Fees: \$45 single-handed, \$65 double-handed, and \$85 triple-handed. *\$10 discount if registration received by June 15. \$5 discount for US Sailing members.* Fee includes lunches for participants Saturday and Sunday, dinner for participants Saturday evening, regatta T-shirt, and two days of racing. Additional meals are available to purchase for family members: \$5 per lunch each day and \$10 for Saturday dinner.

Housing /Site Access: Camping is available on-site in designated areas of the club property. You are welcome to arrive on Friday the 19th but there will be no access to the club until 3 pm Friday afternoon.

Vancouver Lake Sailing Club Rules: 🐕 **NO DOGS ALLOWED** 🐕 or other pets on the host club property. Parking and camping is in designated areas only. Please follow the VLSC rules.
