

2007 Al Morris Regatta Notice of Race

Aug 18 – 19, 2007

Rules: This regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 including US Sailing Prescriptions and the Thistle Class Association except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions.

Registration: By mail (see registration form below) or in person. It is very important that you pre-register for this event.

Racing: We are planning on sailing as many races as possible. There will be no races after 3pm on Sunday

Scoring: The low point scoring system, Appendix A2 will apply. Each boat's score will be the sum of all races sailed.

Early registration bonus (or late registration penalty)

The first 15 boats to request campsites and send in their registration with check will receive a group campsite hangtag, and camping spaces will be assigned. Camping will be available for Friday and Saturday night. Spaces/location will be awarded by the order they are received. The hangtag you receive will allow you to park your vehicle inside the group campsite and does include the launch fee. All other vehicles (beyond the first 15 registrations) must purchase passes and park outside the campsites AT ALL TIMES!

You may purchase an overnight pass that will allow you to park your car in the overflow lot next door. This means that even those who get a hangtag can still only park one vehicle in the site and must purchase hangtags for all other vehicles (and park in the over flow lot). Only one camp space will be assigned per boat. We expect the fees to be as follows: \$2.00 day use, \$3.00 launch, \$5.00 overnight parking in overflow lot just outside group site. These fees apply to any vehicles that do not have one of the 15 hangtags provided to us. Remember, Yale is an alcohol free venue.

Note: If you pre-register you will get a confirmation in the mail (if you are one of the first 15). You MUST bring that confirmation and show it at the gate or you will have to pay to get into the park!!!

How you get to the launch area! Now you to get to either the group campsite or launch area you enter at the first entrance (the first right after metropolis of Cougar). They have rebuilt the bridge that goes across the stream and you actually go across that. The way that we used to enter is now an exit only, so don't miss your turn to drop off the boat! RVs are not allowed in the Cougar camp ground for overnight camping Only tents are allowed in the Cougar group campsite. This also means no "pop-up" tent trailers. You can reserve a camp spot at Beaver Bay campground (a mile or so down the lake) or reserve a spot at the Cougar RV Park.
