NOTICE OF RACE**

Rules: This regatta will be governed by ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2011 and the prescriptions of US Sailing and the applicable one-design class associations, except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions. The low point scoring system Appendix A will apply. Each boat's score will be the sum of all races.

Eligibility: This regatta is open to all one-design sailing dinghies and catamarans, such as Lido, Europes, Tasars, Lasers, Vanguard 15's, Coronado 15's, Snipes, Daysailers, Flying Scots, Lightnings, 420's, 470's, 505's and A-Cats.

Racing: We are planning on sailing as many races as possible. The minimum for a regatta will be three races. There will be no races started after 3pm Sunday.

Tent Camping Details: Tent camping (not RV camping) at

Cougar Camp will be available for Friday and Saturday night.

We expect that our group camp site will accommodate all the tents that participants

will use. However, only 15 vehicles are allowed to park in the group camp area. The

first 15 boats to request and pay for campsites will receive a hangtag that allows you to park your car in the camp site. This tag also covers the day use and launch fees for the park.

All other vehicles beyond the first 15 registrants, and any additional vehicles for the first 15 registrants, must purchase passes at the campground and park their cars in the parking lot across the driveway from the camp site.

We expect the fees to be as follows: \$3.00 day use, \$5.00 launch, \$5.00 overnight parking in overflow lot just outside group site. These fees apply to any vehicles that does not have one of the 15 hangtags.

Cougar Campground is an alcohol free venue.

Note: If you are one of the first 15 campers, you will receive a confirmation email. You MUST bring that confirmation and show it at the gate or you will have to pay to get into the park!

Boat Storage: There is a parking lot at the campground near the boat ramp where competitors can store their boats overnight on trailers, mast up.

RV Camping: RVs are not allowed in the Cougar camp ground for overnight camping. Only tents are allowed in the Cougar group campsite. This also means no "popup" tent trailers. You can get an RV camp spot at Beaver Bay campground (a mile or so down the lake) on a first come, first served basis. Call PacifiCorp's recreation line at (503) 813-6666 for information. You can reserve a spot at Cougar RV Park & Campground, (360) 238-5224.
